Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.139 dated 19.07.2016, registered for offences under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities), 1989, at Police Station “Nakodar, District Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
