Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.15, dated 31.01.2022, under Sections 363/366-A IPC (later on added Sections 7, 8 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is 21 years of age whereas the prosecutrix is 17 ½ years old and they remained together for about a week. He also submits that though in the statement recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C., the victim did not allege anything against the petitioner, however, in the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., under the pressure of her parents, she has deposed against the petitioner.

However, after arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Allowed as prayed for.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the Court concerned within a week from today and files an application for regular bail, then the Court concerned is directed to decide the same within two days thereafter, in accordance with law.
