Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to register a case against respondent No.5 on the basis of the complaints filed by her to the police on 17.06.2019 and 10.09.2019.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that respondent No.4 has made repeated attempts to join the petitioner in the inquiry to be conducted by the police in pursuance to the aforesaid complaints made by the petitioner but she remains elusive.
