SANT PARKASH, J.

The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the averments that the petitioners performed marriage on 28.03.2022 as per Sikh rites and ceremonies against the wishes of respondent No.4 to 8 and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at his instance.

In compliance of the order dated 07.04.2022, learned counsel for the State submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded to the effect that now there is no threat perception to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents and they are not required any protection.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous and the same is disposed of with liberty to get the same restored in case of apprehension of any danger from respondents No. 4 to 8 in future.
