Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 04 dated 02.02.2022, under
Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Thulliwal,
District Barnala.

Vide order dated 07.04.2022, this Court while granting
the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to
join investigation and in view to show her bonafide to deposit Rs. 1
lac with learned trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a
demand draft bearing No. 050890 dated 11.07.2022 in the name of
Harpal Singh-complainant, to learned counsel for the complainant in
the Court today. The photocopy of the same is taken on record.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 07.04.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In view of the petitioner having handed over the demand draft amounting to Rs. 1 lac to the counsel for the complainant in the Court today, he need not to deposit Rs. 1 lac with learned trial Court.
