1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 27.04.2021, in CWP-3911-2021, in case titled as Balbir Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 27.04.2021, reveals that CWP-3911-2021, was disposed of with a direction that the revision/mercy petition filed by the petitioner on 29.02.2016, be decided within eight weeks.

3. Pursuant to notice to respondent No.2, learned DAG, Haryana, has filed copy of order dated 06.05.2022 as per which punishment of stoppage of three annual increments with permanent effect has been reduced to stoppage of one increment only with permanent effect. Order dated 06.05.2022, is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that the petitioner is satisfied with the same and does not wish to pursue the instant petition

and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.2 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
