The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0413 dated 15.03.2022 registered under Sections 323, 379-B, 506, 34 IPC and 3 of the SC&ST Act, which was deleted later, at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram.

The operative part of the order dated 07.04.2022, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 29.03.2022 passed in CRM-M-12978-2022 to submit that the parents of the petitioner have already been granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court.

Notice of motion.... ”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 07.04.2022, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Bablish Kumar, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.04.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
