The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.551 dated 18.10.2021 registered under Sections 365, 372 (2)(n), 376(3) IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar.

Admittedly, only 03 prosecution witnesses remain to be examined in the petitioner's trial and therefore, at its fag end, it is considered undesirable to grant bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, at this stage, the petition is dismissed.

However, in the peculiar facts of this case, a direction is issued to the Trial Court to finally disposed of the petitioner's trial within two months from the next date fixed before it, in accordance with law.
