Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.21 dated 04.03.2022 under Sections 379, 420, and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana, and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise/affidavit dated 28.03.2022 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 19.04.2022, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Ilqa Magistrate on or before 15.07.2022 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the learned Magistrate was directed to send a report about the genuineness and veracity of the compromise.

A report dated 24.08.2022 of learned JMIC, Ludhiana has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Magistrate and got recorded their statements regarding compromise.

Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the

compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.21 dated 04.03.2022 under Sections 379, 420, and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
