The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 58, dated 29.01.2018, lodged under Sections 498-A, 323, 506, 34 & 377 of IPC, registered at Police Station 58, Faridabad (annexed as Annexure P-1).

It is the case of the petitioner that it was on account of matrimonial dispute between him and the complainant-wife that the FIR in question came to be registered.

Learned counsel further submits that pursuant to order dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ash Mohd., does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. He, on further instructions submits that since the petitioner has joined investigation, his further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation is not required.

Heard.

In the facts and circumstances, as enumerated hereinabove, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
