Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to lodge the missing report of Shri Ram @ Monu and also to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7.

In response to the notice of motion dated 30.05.2018, reply by way of affidavit dated 14.08.2018 of Pawan Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Jind has been filed, wherein it is mentioned that Shri Ram @ Monu is an accused in FIR No.71 dated 08.04.2018, under Sections 341, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 Arms Act, Police Station, Julana (Annexure P-1), who is yet to be arrested.

It has been pleaded that the said person, in order to evade his arrest, is concealing himself and the court has already issued warrants of his arrest, therefore, the report regarding his missing cannot be recorded.

Considering the above background and the stand of the State in respect of Shri Ram @ Monu, the representation as well as the petition have been filed to mislead the investigation of FIR No.71 dated 08.04.2018 as the allegations regarding the abduction of Shri Ram @ Monu are not substantiated with any convincing material.

Resultantly, no ground is made out for exercise of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
