LISA GILL, J.

This writ petition has been filed seeking appropriate directions to the learned Executing Court to decide execution petition (Annexure P1) filed by the petitioners in a time bound manner. It is submitted that execution petition was filed by the petitioners in January, 2020 but the matter has not yet been finally concluded. Perusal of the file reveals that soon after filing of the said execution petition, there was outbreak of pandemic COVID-19 leading to restricted functioning of courts. Thereafter, an application under Order 1 Rule 10 (2) read with Section 151 CPC for deletion of respondent No.2 from the array of respondents was filed. Said application was ultimately decided on 16.03.2021. Objections were filed by respondent No. 2. Reply thereto was filed by the petitioners in February, 2022. The matter thereafter has been adjourned on two occasions at request of learned counsel for the parties.

At this stage, I do not find any ground to issue a specific direction to the learned Executing Court as prayed for, however, at the same time am

sanguine that the matter shall be decided by the learned Executing Court expeditiously keeping in view the guidelines laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in **Rahul S. Shah versus Jinendra Kumar Gandhi and others (2021) 6 Supreme Court cases 418.**

Present revision petition is, accordingly disposed of.
