The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to direct respondent No.3 to follow the procedure mentioned in Section 41-A of Cr.P.C. and not to harass the petitioner. It is further prayed that respondent No.2 be directed to decide the representation dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-1)

Notice served upon the official respondents through State's counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case direction be issued to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, to decide the representation dated 04.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala, is directed to decide the representation by passing a speaking order within ***ten working days*** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent above. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
