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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

By filing this petition under Section 482 CrP.C. the petitioner has sought direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action on his representation dated 31.03.2022 regarding threats given by respondents No.4 and 5.

The facts as narrated in the petition are that the engagement of the daughter of the petitioner was solemnised with respondent No.4 in February 2021 and the marriage was celebrated on 04.03.2022. It is the case of the petitioner that later the petitioner and his family came to know that respondent No.4 is paralysed from both hands and left leg and is unable to work. When the petitioner raised the issue, threats have allegedly been extended to him and his family by respondent No.4 and 5 stating that if the daughter of the petitioner is not sent to the matrimonial home the entire family would be liquidated. It is stated that a representation Annexure P-1 has been submitted to the official respondents No.2 and 3 but no action has

been taken.

In the petition as also in the representation Annexure P-1, only vague and bald allegations of threats having been extended by respondents No.4 and 5 have been made. No particulars have been mentioned. Hence in the facts and circumstances as disclosed in the petition no direction can be issued by this court.

Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to take alternative remedies before appropriate forum with regard to the fraud allegedly committed by the respondents.
