AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the revision petition which has been preferred by the petitioner titled as '*Shamsher Singh Vs. Jagbir Singh and others*' along with an application for stay stands filed on 17.03.2022, which is pending consideration before the Revisional Authority for 28.04.2022. His submission is that the warrants of possession have been issued for 21.04.2022 and in case the said warrants are executed and possession taken, the revision petition would be rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the State was requested to seek instructions in the matter and when the matter has again been taken up for consideration after the lunch break, she has informed that the Revisional Authority may not be available prior to the date fixed in the revision petition as he is on leave and therefore, the hearing of the application and the revision petition would not be possible to be preponed.

In light of the above and keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, we dispose of the present writ petition with the observations that *status quo* with regard to the possession, as it exists today, shall be maintained till 28.04.2022, the date on which the revision petition along with the application for stay is pending. In case the said stay application is not decided on the date fixed i.e. 28.04.2022, the Revisional Authority shall make an endeavour to decide the same at the earliest and in any case not beyond 15 days.

Till the decision is taken on the application for stay, the order of *status quo*, which has been passed by this Court as recorded above, shall enure.
