The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.111 dated 08.11.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Tasikka District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that subsequent to the registration of the FIR in question, the victim on attaining the age of majority, had got married to the petitioner and out of the said wedlock, a child too had been born. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 25.10.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarbjit Singh does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. She, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 25.10.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
