Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, seeking direction to the respondents to consider and promote the petitioners for the post of Agriculture Extension Officers.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case, representation dated 01.08.2021 (P-8) is decided expeditiously.

Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Punjab, to consider the aforesaid representation (or any other comprehensive representation that may be made within two weeks from today), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
