Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to expedite the proceedings in case bearing No.COMA 9 of 2019 instituted on 02.01.2019 titled as 'M/s Kay Jain Processors vs. Venus Garments (India) Ltd. & others' under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and to direct the Trial Court to conclude the proceedings within a period of six months.

A perusal of the zimni orders of trial Court clearly shows that the complaint has been requesting for adjournments on multiples occasions. The present petition, filed for seeking expedience adjudication of the complaint at the behest of the complaint, thus has no substance.
