This petition was filed seeking directions to protect the life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of respondent No.4. Further direction was sought to SSP to arrest respondent No.4 in FIR No.36 dated 16.4.2018, under Sections 201, 218, 221 IPC and Section 13(1)(d)(i) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar Rural.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh submits that a cancellation report in FIR no. 36 dated 16.4.2018 has been filed before the Court concerned. He further submits that on assessment no threat perception was found.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance if any.

Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
