Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.91 dated 25.06.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 308, 506 and 23 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Rupnagar.

On 08.04.2022 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that after dismissal of the first petition filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail the petitioner and the complainant have compromised the matter.

Notice of motion.

Ms.Gunkirat Kaur, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr.Ajay Pal Singh Rehan, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant. For arguments, adjourned to 30.08.2022.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.91, dated 25.06.2021, registered under Sections 323, 341, 308, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation which is now complete and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the admitted position that the matter between the petitioner and the complainant has been compromised and the afore-referred statement made by learned State counsel, the order of this Court dated 08.04.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
