Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0001 dated 08.01.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Vide order dated 20.03.2020 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.03.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that the parties were referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the matter is amicably settled. He has submitted that in view of the compromise arrived at, petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act is also filed in which first motion statement is recorded.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjeet Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation

and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.03.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
