ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)

Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* to set aside the impugned order dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, whereby the Female Head Warders were directed to participate in the online transfer drive.

Learned State counsel submits that per his instructions, even though the transfer policy has been framed but as of now, there is no contemplation to carry out any transfers qua the Female Head Warders, serving in the Prisons Department in the State of Haryana.

Being so, it appears that the writ petition has been filed pre-maturely on an unfounded apprehension that since the transfer policy has been framed and therefore, compulsorily the same will result in en-mass transfers under the same.

In view of the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach at appropriate stage, in case there is any contemplation to carry out any transfers.
