Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail has been moved by petitioner in case FIR No.29 dated 02.02.2020 under Sections 120-B, 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District S.A.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of One Time Settlement (OTS) arrived at between the petitioner and respondent No.2/complainant Bank, petitioner has already deposited the settled amount in favour of complainant Bank and to this effect 'No Due Certificate' has already been issued by the Bank concerned.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant Bank has given concurrence to the abovesaid aspect.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Nirmal Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 18.08.2021, petitioner has already joined investigation and is not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

In view of above, order dated 18.08.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
