Present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 for carrying out fair and transparent investigation in case FIR No.119 dated 20.09.2016 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Notice of motion in this case was issued on 09.04.2021.

Learned State counsel submits that 15 days' time was granted by this Court to take steps to make the accused join proceedings. However, on instructions received from SI Valaitiram, he submits that three raids were conducted at the house of respondent No.4, however, the accused was not found there whereupon they were apprised that respondent No.4 does not reside at that given address. He further submits that an application for declaring her PO has been initiated and the same is pending for 03.12.2022.

In view of the aforesaid, learned State counsel submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case.

Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of alternate remedy, available to him, in accordance with law.
