Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0400 dated 10.08.2015 under Sections 279/337 IPC registered at Police Station South Sector-34, Chandigarh, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner, who was on regular bail, absented from trial proceedings, whereupon his bail was cancelled by the trial Court vide order dated 17.01.2020.

Considering the above background as well as the decision of this Court dated 04.04.2019 delivered by this Court in ***CRM-M No.15464 of 2019 (Balwant Singh @ Banta Versus State of Punjab)***, the present petition is not maintainable, therefore, the same is dismissed, however, it shall be open for the petitioner to avail the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
