SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to get opinion regarding injuries suffered by the petitioner, from PGI Rohtak in FIR No.186 dated 06.09.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh and also for deciding the representation dated 25.11.2021 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner.

It is submitted that accused namely Ejaz alias Ejju picked up a quarrel with petitioner's nephew aged about 12/13 years on 16.09.2021 at about 7.00 p.m. at their shop as petitioner's nephew refused to give some articles to the aforesaid accused on credit basis. On the same evening at around 8.00 p.m., when the petitioner along with his nephew was going to their house after closing their shop, the said accused Ejaz along with 14 other persons armed with sticks and axes encircled the petitioner and his nephew and started beating them mercilessly. On hearing noise at the spot, family members of petitioner also reached there. As a result thereof, the petitioner received injury on his head and his family members also received

various injuries on their person. The petitioner requested respondents No.2 and 3 many times to get a report from board of doctors of PGI, Rohtak, with regard to the injuries having been suffered by the petitioner, but to no avail. Consequently, the petitioner moved a representation dated 25.11.2021 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat), but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amreek Singh Narwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat) to decide the representation dated 25.11.2021 (Annexure P-3) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat) for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
