Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the FIR No.26 dated 25.4.2019, registered under Section 498-A IPC (Section 354 IPC added later on) vide DDR NO.39 dated 10.10.2019 at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar and the proclamation proceedings initiated against the petitioner and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-5).

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail his remedy before the trial Court/Court concerned where the PO proceedings have been initiated. He submits that the petitioner has already been granted the benefit of anticipatory bail. He further submits that the marriage already stands dissolved under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. He submits that the petitioner is keen to appear before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedy before the court concerned. The learned trial Court is requested to deal with all his pleas sympathetically in accordance with law.
