Although the prayer made in the application is for amendment of the head note and prayer clause of the main petition as also for placing on record the amended petition, but the permission to amend has already been granted by this Court vide order dated 04.04.2022.

However, the prayer for placing on record the amended petition is accepted.

Amended petition is taken on record.

Application is disposed of.

Main case

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.100

dated 17.03.2021, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 307, 354-A, 323, 377, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station I.M.T., Rohtak, District Rohtak, Annexure P-1.

Counsel submits that FIR is a fallout of a matrimonial dispute, wherein allegations were levelled by his wife-complainant against the petitioner as well as the in-laws and her brother-in-law. Counsel submits that during investigation, the relatives of the petitioner have been found to be innocent. Counsel submits that vide order dated 26.07.2021, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation and was ordered to be released on interim bail. He submits that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

Upon instructions received from SI, Budh Singh, State counsel has confirmed this fact and has stated that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Petition is allowed.

Order dated 26.07.2021 is made absolute, subject to the fulfilment of conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
