Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the State to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.140 dated 19.08.2017 registered under Sections 354, 149, 295 IPC at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that after investigation conducted in pursuance to the FIR in question, the State has prepared and filed a report before the competent Court seeking cancellation of the same which remains pending.

In the light of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

It is made clear that this would not debar the petitioner for raising any protest against the cancellation report before the competent report where it has been filed by the State.
