The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the adhoc service, which the petitioner had rendered with the respondent-department from 03.02.1973 till 22.10.1973 should also be taken into account as qualifying service for computing his pensionary benefits keeping in view the settled principle of law settled by the Full Bench of this Court in **Kesar Chand vs. State of Punjab and others AIR 1988 Punjab, 265.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P/5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction be issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present

in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P/5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P/5), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P/5) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
