Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to take appropriate action against the private respondents, who are alleged to have forcibly taken the petitioner's daughter.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the investigations conducted in pursuance to the representations submitted by the petitioner have revealed that the petitioner's daughter, who is a major, had joined the company of respondent No.5 as per her own sweet will and has since left his company to live in her parental house with the petitioner.
