The instant application has been filed under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for placing on record the true translated extract copy of the FIR No. 0272 registered under Section 3 and 25 of the Arms Act dated 02.06.2022, at Police Station Suratgarh, District Ganganagar (Rajasthan) as Annexure P-8 and the photocopy of the license as Annexure P-9 and also seeking exemption from filing certified copies thereof.

Application is allowed as prayed for and true translated extract copy of the FIR No. 0272 registered under Section 3 and 25 of the Arms Act dated 02.06.2022, at Police Station Suratgarh, District Ganganagar (Rajasthan) and the photocopy of the license are taken on record as Annexure P-8 and P-9.

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 01.11.2021 (Annexure P-7) whereby the respondents have refused to provide security to the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the threat perception of the petitioner is not assessed by the respondent-authorities and rejecting the representation submitted by the petitioner. He prays that he may be granted liberty to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the respondent-authorities to move an appropriate representation by placing the entire document showing real and tangible apprehension of the petitioner and threat to his life and to pursue the same with respondent-authorities in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdraw with liberty as aforesaid.
