1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 08.07.2020, in CWP-9431-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 08.07.2020, reveals that CWP-9431-2020, was disposed of by directing respondent No. 2 to take a decision on legal notice dated 25.03.2020, filed on behalf of the petitioner by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and communicate the decision taken to the petitioner.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced speaking order dated 09.05.2022, rejecting the claim as contained in legal notice served on behalf of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof

states that in the circumstances the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 09.05.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law. .

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.2, under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
