In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they were working as Extension Lecturer with the respondent No.3-College but, they were relieved from service on the ground that the regular employees have already joined in their place despite the fact that workload existed so as to allow the petitioners to continue in service.

The Government of Haryana have issued Instructions for readjustment of the Displaced Lecturers on 04.03.2020, which have been further amended on 11.05.2022 so as to readjust the relieved Extension Lecturers.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioners intend to avail the benefit of the Instructions dated 04.03.2020 issued by the Government of Haryana read with clarification dated

11.05.2022 so as to claim the benefit of readjustment as Extension Lecturer, they are free to raise their claim by filing appropriate representation and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners, the same will be decided in accordance with law by the respondents within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of said representation and in case the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to them within a period of next four weeks.

Keeping in view the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court in the present writ petition and the same is disposed off with liberty to the petitioners to file an appropriate representation so as to claim the benefit before the respondents.

Ordered accordingly.
