It is submitted that respondent No.6 was evicted in proceedings initiated under Public Premises (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1973. The eviction order has become final and yet, the said respondent has not been dispossessed. Repeated representations have been made but to no avail. Finally, the representation dated 14.10.2021 (Annexure P-6) has also been submitted but no action has been taken.

Thus, a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action in accordance with the representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Arun K.Kaundal, DAG, Punjab accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.2 to decide the pending representation dated 14.10.2021 (Annexure P-6)

in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
