Instant writ petition was filed assailing the orders dated 27.12.2019 (Annexure P-16) and also 18.02.2020 (Annexure P-22) rejecting the petitioner's applications filed in Form SVLDRS-1 to avail of the benefit under Sabka Vishwas (Legacy Disputes Resolution) Scheme 2019.

During the course of hearing today, counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the relief has since been granted to the petitioner. In this regard, the discharge certificate in Form SVLDRS-4 has been made available for perusal of this court which would clearly indicate that the applicant has been discharged from the burden of any further duty, interest or penalty in respect of time period 2013-2014 and 2015-2016. Copy of discharge certificate is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

In the light of such development, there would be no occasion to go into the legality of the impugned orders Annexure P-16 and P-22 and the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.

Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
