Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents, who are harassing the petitioners with regard to the cheques, which were allegedly issued by the petitioners to private respondents, who have already filed a civil suit in this regard.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Civil Lines, Ludhiana, is on record and as per the reply, on receiving the representation dated 18.10.2019, the matter was enquired by the police after issuing notice to the petitioners, however, they did not join the investigation rather it came that FIR No.442 dated 09.10.2019, stands registered against the petitioners in Police Station Bilaspur, District Rampur. Thereafter, by joining the private respondents, the matter was enquired into and it was found that FIR

No.7 dated 11.01.2019 under Sections 279, 337, 427 IPC Police Station PAU, Ludhiana, stands registered against the driver of the tractor-trolley Vikram Singh and Ramesh Kumar @ Ram Niwas. Later on, Ramesh Kumar @ Ram Niwas was found innocent. It is also stated that on conclusion of the enquiry, no substance was found and the same was filed.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
