The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.16 dated 26.01.2022 registered under Sections 498A, 406, 506 IPC at Police Station City, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

By virtue of the order dated 21.04.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 21.04.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He further submits that as per order dated 24.08.2022, parties had appeared before the Mediation Centre for exploring the possibility of amicable settlement. However, the same remained unsuccessful.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 opposes the submissions

made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 21.04.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
