The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to grant compassionate employment to the petitioner under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Cooperative Sugar Mills Employees Rules, 2005.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the husband of the petitioner, who was working as a Clerk, had expired due to Covid-19 pandemic. He further contends that the petitioner is a widow and has to look after two minor children and aged mother-in-law. He further contends that the petitioner does not have any source of income. The petitioner had applied for compassionate appointment. He also contends that respondent No.3 has sent the case of the petitioner to respondent No.2 to grant relaxation in terms of Rule 17 of the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Cooperative Sugar Mills Employees Rules, 2005.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
