In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the daily wage service, which the late husband of the petitioner had rendered with the respondent-Nigam from 1980 to 1993 has not been taken into account as qualifying service for computing the pensionary benefits by the respondents, which act of the respondents is contrary to the settled principle of law as well as the rules governing the service.

After notice of motion, respondents have appeared. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner was reconsidered and an order dated 08.09.2022 has been passed by the respondents, by which, the benefit of daily wage service rendered by late husband of the petitioner from 06.01.1984 to 03.05.1993 has been given by counting the said period as qualifying service for computing the pensionary

benefits as no record prior to the said date was available with the department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to the respondents to implement the order dated 08.09.2022 passed by them in a time bound manner so as to grant the consequential benefits to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the consequential benefits in terms of the order dated 08.09.2022 passed by the respondents will be released to the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may be disposed off having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
