The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0213 dated 27.09.2021 under Sections 323, 325, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Section 308 IPC was added later on registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.08.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 17.08.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.08.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
