Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.0047 dated 21.1.2022 registered under Sections 457, 380 IPC (Sections 411 and 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Parao Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

As per allegations in the FIR, *Unnani* medicines were stored by the complainant in his warehouse situated in the area of Dukheri Road, Ambala Cantt. The complainant informed to the police that during the night intervening between 20/21.1.2022, some unknown persons committed theft of the goods lying in the said warehouse.

Admittedly, the petitioner was not named in the FIR. Husband of the petitioner namely Jasbir Singh was nominated as accused on the basis of the disclosure made by co-accused and thereafter, Jasbir Singh was arrested. Only allegations against the petitioner are that Jasbir Singh

disclosed to the police that after selling the stolen goods, he gave its sale

proceeds to the present petitioner.

The petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in light of order of interim bail dated 13.4.2022 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court. State counsel on instructions from HC Ved Prakash apprised the Court that an amount of ₹ 5,000/- has been recovered from the petitioner and she is not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 13.4.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
