Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.19 dated 24.01.2020 registered under Section 420 IPC(later on added Sections 66 C & 66 D of IT Act), Police Station 11, Chandigarh.

As per allegations in the FIR lodged by doctor Vipul Aggarwal, petitioner and some other persons committed fraud through online mode with him and Rs.40,000/- deducted from his SBI account and transferred to Paytm account No.7699989148 and out of the same amount Rs.20,000/- was further transferred in the name of the present petitioner.

The petitioner was arrested and as per custody certificate furnished by the U.T. counsel the total custody period of the petitioner comes to be 2 months and 11 days and he is not involved in any other criminal case. It appears that now compromise has been effected between the parties and copy of concerned affidavit of Doctor Vipul Aggarwal is Annexure P-2. The U.T. counsel admitted the fact that the aforesaid amount of Rs.40,000/- has already been repaid by the accused to the complainant. Further challan has already been presented in the court concerned, after completion of investigation. It will take time for completion of the trial.

In view of the above, no purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any further period. Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned during the pendency of the trial.
