Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to step up the pay of petitioner at par with proforma respondent No.4. Further prayer is for directing the official respondents to decide the representation/legal notice dated 10.01.2022 (P-7).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the Legal Notice dated 10.01.2022 (P-7) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 10.01.2022 (P-7) by passing speaking order as per law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
