The present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.58, dated 24.3.2022, registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 8.4.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further submits the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 8.4.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
