The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.103 dated 12.10.2019 under Sections 3(1)(x) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and Sections 447, 511, 323, 505, 294-A, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.04.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed an affidavit of Mr. Jaspreet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Phagwara, District Kapurthala, Punjab in court which is taken on record and on from ASI Jaswinder Pal instructions submits that the petitioner has joined

investigation in terms of orders dated 08.04.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.04.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
