This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action against respondent Nos.5 to 8 for sacrilege of religious place and hurting the religious feelings of the community and also giving threats to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the representation 20.21.2022 (Annexure P-4) and submitted that respondent Nos.5 to 8 misbehaved in the fair organized at Takia Meer Shah, but despite a specific complaint, no action has been taken upon the same. He prays for issuance of necessary directions.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the representation dated 20.01.2022 has been given recently, during the 3rd wave of COVID-19 and the same is pending consideration.

Resultantly, this Court is not inclined to exercise inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at this stage.
