AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the State, in pursuance to the order dated 18.04.2022, has informed the Court that the next date of hearing in the appeal is 19.05.2022 and the appeal shall be decided within a period of three months thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order dated 15.12.2021 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Additional Chief Secretary, Town and Country Planning, to contend that in the light of the undertaking which has been given by the private respondents, the stay was not granted by the said authority, especially when it was stated that in case new construction is to be undertaken, permission will be taken from the said authority. He submitted that photographs (Annexure P-5) show clearly that the construction at the site is in progress.

If that be so, let the petitioner bring this fact to the notice of the Additional Chief Secretary, Town and Country Planning/Appellate Authority, who shall thereafter proceed to pass appropriate orders thereon after issuing notice to the private respondents.

The writ petition is disposed of with above observations.
