This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue/rectify the birth certificate of the petitioner as per the record maintained by the petitioner.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner dated 10.03.2022 (Annexure P-8) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jaivir Chandail, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Dr. Anand Bishnoi, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3. Even counsel for the respondents are not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 10.03.2022 (Annexure P-8) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
