Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Seeking an opportunity to furnish bail bonds before learned trial Court
in compliance of the order dated 10.12.2021(P-2).

Notice of motion.

Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on
behalf of respondent/State.

Vide judgment and order dated 11.11.2021 of learned
Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot, the petitioner was
convicted for an offence under Section 174-A IPC and sentenced to
undergo imprisonment for six months. He filed an appeal there
against. Vide order dated 10.12.2021 of learned Additional Sessions
Judge, Pathankot, the sentence awarded to the petitioner was directed
to remain suspended during the pendency of the appeal subject to the
petitioner furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- and one
surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned trial Court,
Pathankot within 15 days. However, the petitioner did not furnish the

requisite bail bonds before the trial Court on 11.01.2021 and moved an application for extension of time for furnishing bail bonds. The said application was allowed. The petitioner was given 10 more days for furnishing bail bonds before the trial Court. He still did not furnish the bail bonds and thereafter moved an another application seeking extension of time to furnish the bail bonds, which has been dismissed vide order dated 30.03.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is employed as a cook in Ranjit Sagar Dam. Due to exigency of service he was unable to furnish the bail bonds, he prays that ten more days be granted to the petitioner to furnish the bail bonds.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted ten more days i.e. uptill 18.04.2022 to furnish the bail bonds before the trial Court in terms of the order dated 10.12.2021.
